MATERNAL HISTORY

Ryan was born at 39 0/7 weeks (by dates) to a 27 year old woman who was G 1 and P 0 at the time of delivery.

Prenatal Labs: Blood Type: **A** Rh: **neg** Antibody: **Negative** Hepatitis B: **negative**

Rubella status: **immune** RPR: **nonreactive** Length ROM: **15 hr(s) and 32 min.**

GBS Status: **negative**

Labor Tmax: **38.2**

Antibiotics: **therapeutic < 4 hr**

Glucose testing: **normal GLT**

Maternal diagnoses and procedures during the pregnancy, labor and delivery included:

Antepartum events: Uterine myomas, Amniocentesis (Genetic) (Prenatal) L&D events: Repair of obstetric laceration, Advanced Maternal Age (nulliparous) (35years), Prolonged 2nd Stage of labor (>3 hrs with epidural, Rupture of Membranes Prior to Labor (Term), Moderate Variable Decelerations, Electronic Fetal Monitoring(labor), Maternal fever in labor (38.2°), Antibiotics before delivery-prophylactic

History multiple fibroids. Temperature spike to 38.2 before delivery, antibiotic given x1, not continued after delivery.

DELIVERY vaginal cephalic, low forceps

Apgars 1 min: **09** 5 min: **09** 10 min: **NA**

Resuscitation: Suction only

Henry Resuscitator, M.D. was called to the delivery room because of forceps delivery. Delivery analgesia used: narcotic, epidural. The respiratory effort at birth was spontaneous. Delivery outcome: live birth admit-regular care.

Weight (g): 3386 (7 lbs, 7 oz) Length (cm): 48 Head circ (cm): 34.5 GA Exam: 39 0/7 wks AGA

GENERAL: alert and active, pink and well perfused

SKIN: no icterus or rashes; very superficial abrasions scalp and cheeks.

HEAD: open, flat anterior fontanelle

EYES: normal shape and size, equal red reflexes

EARS: normally set, no anomalies

NOSE & MOUTH: nares appear patent, intact palate

NECK & CLAVICLES: no masses, intact clavicles

LUNGS & CHEST: symmetric chest, no distress, clear and equal breath sounds

CARDIAC: normal rate and rhythm, no murmurs, pulses equal in all 4 extremities

ABDOMEN & CORD: soft, non-tender, no organomegaly or masses, 3 vessel cord

GENITALIA: normal external genitalia

BACK & SPINE: straight spine

LIMBS & HIPS: symmetric, moves all 4 well, stable hips, 10 fingers and toes

NEUROLOGIC: normal suck, symmetric Moro, good strength and tone

Interim events: breast fed well, some emesis x2, mucous, old blood				
Exam: normal exam, no cardiorespiratory distress, passing stool and urine				

Blood type: A-. DAT: Negative

Social issues: discussed care with the family

INTERIM Hx: breast fed well, though a little dry on the mucous membranes today, otherwise doing well. mom seems comfortable with baby. dad asking questions about pacifiers. no acute changes over last day

EXAM

Weight (g): 3128 (6 lbs, 14 oz)

GENERAL: alert and active, pink and well perfused

SKIN: no rashes, very mild facial icterus

HEAD: open, flat anterior fontanelle

EYES: no anomalies, equal red reflexes

EARS: normally set, no anomalies

NOSE & MOUTH: nares patent, palate intact, tacky mucous membranes

NECK & CLAVICLES: no neck masses, intact clavicles

LUNGS & CHEST: no distress, clear and equal breath sounds

CARDIAC: normal rate and rhythm, no murmurs, good femoral pulses

ABDOMEN & CORD: soft, non-tender, no masses or organomegaly, drying cord

GENITALIA: normal external genitalia, circumcised, testes descended

BACK & SPINE: straight spine

LIMBS & HIPS: moves all 4 limbs, stable hips

NEUROLOGIC: normal suck, symmetric Moro, good strength and tone

Special considerations: primip mom, working on breast feeds. baby a little dry on d/c day. check on status

State newborn screen: pending
