### LABOR SUMMARY

Lucille Smith is a 26 year old, Gravida 1, Para 0, with an LMP of 5/30/2005 and an EDD of 3/6/2006, who was admitted on 12/19/2005 at 29 0/7 weeks of gestation for preterm labor.

Prenatal events included: Maternal transport, Preterm labor with delivery, Tocolytic therapy, Steroids - complete course, Suspected Fetal Macrosomia (LGA), Ultrasound (Prenatal), Group B Streptococcus Carrier

Labor was spontaneous. Fetal monitoring was by external monitor. At the time of spontaneous rupture of membranes, the amniotic fluid was clear. Epidural analgesia was used in labor.

Length of Latent Phase: 5hrs and 55min. Total length of ROM prior to delivery: 9 hrs and 25min.

Labor and delivery diagnoses and procedures included: Rupture of Membranes Prior to Labor (Preterm), Intrapartum Retained Placenta with Hemorrhage, Placental abnormality: abruptio placenta, Placental abnormality, Electronic Fetal Monitoring(labor), Amniotic Fluid Index (AFI).

### DELIVERY SUMMARY: Singleton Gestation

The infant presented at birth as occiput anterior at +4 station. Delivery anesthesia: epidural (Chris Anesthesia, M.D.). The method of delivery was: vaginal cephalic, spontaneous assisted at 08:45 on 12/20/2005.
